Dear Sunwarrior Partner,

We would like to thank you for your continued work and partnership. We are very fortunate to have such great partners working with us to make Sunwarrior what it is today, and we are looking forward to what the future will bring.

In an effort to increase the speed and accuracy of our raw material processing, Sunwarrior is requiring that all palletized and small parcel deliveries contain a sticker with five 128-Barcodes (See appendix A for example). These barcodes will enable our warehouses and manufacturing facilities to increase efficiency when receiving, testing, and blending our raw materials. They will also increase payment process speeds. Sunwarrior will begin monitoring compliance to this guideline starting on August 10<sup>th</sup> 2020. One label per pallet or per shipment if it is less than a pallet is required. There is an option to send the barcode on a sheet of paper or in an email with the packing slip and CofA. There will be \$25.00 fee for every barcode that is missed. It is imperative that the information is correct on the label and is scannable.

We believe that this new labeling system will be beneficial to both Sunwarrior and our partners. As Sunwarrior grows and its supply chain increases in complexity, these systems will ensure that growth is aided by robust processes and stronger supplier relationships.
