## Citrus Thin



<b>Product</b>	Citrus Thin (Orange Terpenes Flavour Fragrance Grade distilled in Australia)
<b>Size</b>	1L
<b>Description</b>	Citrus Thin is pure d-limonene, which is derived from citrus peels and is 100% natural and eco-friendly. An excellent alternative to petrochemical solvents such as turpentine. Ideal to use with Gilly's Pure Tung Oil for water repellent timber treatment.
<b>Used For</b>	Thinner, cleaner, solvent, fragrance, paint stripper, a component in coatings.
<b>Surface Preparation for use with Gilly's Pure Tung Oil</b>	Ensure the surface is clean and dry before application. Gilly's Citrus Thin or a turpentine can be used for a vigorous clean. For a lighter clean, you can use an all purpose cleaner. If there is any oil, wax, grease, dirt or similar residue on the surface, it may affect the tung oils ability to cure - so a thorough clean is important.
<b>How to Apply with Gilly's Pure Tung Oil</b>	Mix with Gilly's Pure Tung Oil at a ratio of 50/50. Rub or brush mixture into the timber. Lighter coats are better. Let it sit for 5 minutes. Wipe on more oil to areas that become dull, as the oil soaks in. Wipe off the excess oil, then lightly sand back whilst still damp. Use 320 grit or finer. Apply 3 coats, repeating the same procedure. Best to wait 24 hours between coats. Apply more coats if desired or necessary. Hang out any rags or soak in water.
<b>Dry Time for use with Gilly's Pure Tung Oil</b>	24 hours to dry between coats. As this is tung oil based, it can take 4 weeks to completely cure. Light usage is however perfectly fine within this time.
<b>Maintenance</b>	For general maintenance and wear, you can assess as you see fit. We would recommend reapplying a light 1-2 coats every 6 months to keep your timber looking fresh
<b>Clean Up</b>	Soapy water for hands, brushes and cloths.

<p><b>Safety</b></p>	<p>Flammable Liquid and Vapour. Keep away from sparks and open flames. No smoking. IF ON SKIN (or hair): Rinse skin thoroughly with very soapy water after handling.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Use in a well ventilated area. Wear a protective mask, if in enclosed space.</li> <li>● Gloves are recommended</li> <li>● Hang out rags to dry, or soak in water.
