I, Joe, as the editor of this publication, have not been following through to get editions of this newsletter created and into your hands on a regular basis. For that I am sorry. However, I am happy to report that following the SCGA post-weighoff wrap-up meeting, I have worked with our members to reignite the newsletter as well as other initiatives within the club. And thanks to the generous contributions of members who are willing to step up and take on various responsibilities, our club will continue to grow in its ability to deliver value to its membership.



2013 season recap: What started off as the coldest, wettest season in recent memory ultimately turned out to be an incredible, record-setting year for growers in the upper-midwest. Notably, Stillwater Harvest-Fest's top-ten site average clocked in at an astounding 1499lbs! That is a 16% increase over last year's TTA of 1291lbs. This effort also resulted in Stillwater Harvest-Fest capturing the #2 TTA world-wide. Elk Grove, CA took the #1 spot within a runaway TTA of 1563lbs.

Notable accomplishments by SCGA members: Chris Stevens' HarvestFest-winning 1783lb pumpkin was

8th largest official entry in the world this year and is WI's second largest pumpkin (right behind Chris's 2010 world record 1810.5). Joe Werner blew the doors off the MN state record with a 1779lb entry that earned him 2nd place at HarvestFest and the #9 spot worldwide. Scott Steil (1734lbs), Garry Gantner (1625lbs), and Pete Midthun (1546lbs) rounded out the top five, each of them setting personal bests at the scale.
