


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Welcome

- Do not use accessories other than those specifically recommended for the product.
- · Do not use this product outdoors.
- Please read the instruction manual carefully before operation.
- Any usage other than that specified in this instruction manual may be dangerous, and is forbidden.
- For optimal results, do not exceed 20 minutes of usage per session.
- · Do not use if leather is broken or damaged.
- · Do not use if the cover is damaged.
- · Do not use if the radiator hole is covered or blocked.
- · Do not drop anything into this product.
- · Do not fall asleep while using this product.
- Do not use if you are under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or prescription medications.


6. Trouble shooting: Solutions for common malfunctions

- It is normal to hear the motor during usage.
- If the controller doesn't work, check the plug and socket to ensure there is an adequate connection. Make sure the switch is turned on.
- The product will automatically switch off when it needs to cool down. This
 feature is designed to protect your safety and enhance the lifespan of the
 product. If the product activates the automatic shut down feature, leave it to
 rest for half an hour before using again.

Safety Warnings


WARNING

DO NOT apply downward pressure to the footrest when it is raised. This could cause the massage chair to fall forward, resulting in personal injury or damage to the product.




WARNING

Before sitting on the massage chair, make sure that the massage hand stays in the seat cushion position to avoid discomfort to the buttocks during use and damage to the massage hand.




MARNING

DO NOT try to pull out the control cable or power cord during standby or power on states due to the risk of electric shock or damage to the product. Always unplug the controller cable and power cord and put away after you use the chair.




MARNING

Massage Chair Overview




Function & Features Overview

- This product is designed with an intelligent, silent 3D massage hand that can move up and down, push forward and retract backwards.
- It can automatically detect the shoulder position and can also be manually adjusted.
- Provides a customised massage by detecting the natural curves of your body and spine and auto
 adjusting the motion of the massage hand moving forward and back to vary the length of the
 movements.
- Features eight special automatic massage functions: Fast, Comfort, Relax, Stretch, Full body, Shoulder and neck, Back and waist, Gentle Traction and Full air pressure.
- Three memory functions: program memory I, program memory II, program memory III.
- The Upper Body manual massage function features five kinds of massage position options: Full, Partial, Fixed point, Upper back and Lower back. There are six massage techniques: Kneading, Tapping, Shiatsu, Kneading and tapping, Shoulder grasp and 3D. The massage has five adjustable speeds. When using the Shiatsu or Tapping mode, the robot massage hand adjusts to five different widths.
- Air Massage function: arm pressure massage function (designed with 8 airbags), upper arm
 pressure massage function (designed with 4 airbags), and three levels of air pressure intensity
 adjustment.
- Air pressure massage function: upper arm air pressure massage (4 built in airbags) lower arm
 massage function (4 built in airbags) side cushion air pressure massage (4 built in air bags) waist
 air pressure massage function, (4 built in airbags), leg and hip air pressure massage function (26
 built in airbags), foot air pressure massage function (18 built in airbags), and three levels of air
 pressure intensity adjustment.
- The back and leg heating function uses carbon fibre as an infrared heating source.
- The product is designed with a wall-saver function, so the chair will slide forward when the back rest reclines down.
- The backrest rail adopts 'SL' rail technology, which fits perfectly with the curve of your back, so you
 can enjoy a form fitting massage..
- Intelligent voice control and identification function (microphone in left side speaker).
- Music play system: features 3D digital speakers in the left and right upper arms.
- Can play music by connecting with Bluetooth on your smart phone or other smart device.
- Waist twisting function: uses the left and right waist airbags to swing the waist, relieving tension in the waist muscles resulting from a sedentary lifestyle or too much time sitting.
- The right arm rest is equipped with a Power button, 3D Intensity dial, Footrest Length adjustment button, Negative ions button, Heating button, Auto Mode button, Recline angle adjust button, Voice Control button and a Zero Gravity adjust.
- Leg lifting and recline adjustment. Lifting or recline adjustment of leg and back, Zero Gravity I or Zero Gravity II.
- Foot roller massage function: at the bottom of the foot rest there are rotating massage heads to
 massage the base of your toes and additional rollers to provide a deep, scraping massage to the
 arches and heels of your feet.
- The foot rest is equipped with an automatic sensor to detect the leg length. When the leg is raised
 or reclined to a suitable angle, the foot rest will automatically detect the length of the leg and
 provide a targeted massage to exactly the right area.
- Arm rest LED light decoration.
- The upper arms are fitted with a width adjustment function, which adjusts in two steps adapting to different shoulder widths.
- Shutdown automatic reset function, massage robot automatic reset function.
- Configuring TFT colour screen manual controller.






2.1 Standby

The massage chair cannot enter any mode of operation in standby mode and will display the logo until the Power button is pressed.



2.2 Start massage

Press "Power" button to start Chair. The back rest maintains the default position, leg rest raises slightly. Choose an Auto mode to start the Body Sensing and Shoulder detection process. The massage chair will shut down automatically if a selection is not made within 5 minutes.







2.3 Body Sensing & Shoulder Adjustment

Choose one automatic mode, then back rest and leg rest position will adjust to a standard fixed angle.

After adjusting the angle, the massage chair will automatically detect the shoulder position and body (note: Fast mode only detects shoulder position, other modes detect whole body and shoulder position). Wait for the detection to complete during which you will hear beeping. If you press the "OK" button before detection completes, the massage chair will start massaging in the default setting without shoulder positioning and body sensing adjustments.



After the shoulder detection and adjusting completes, you can adjust the shoulder position by pressing the up or down button to modify the setting. There are 11 levels for shoulder adjustment. If no adjustment occurs for 10 seconds, the massage function will commence automatically.





Description

Move the massage balls upward to a suitable position.


Move the massage balls downward to a suitable position.

After the massage starts you can adjust the shoulder position by selecting the Shoulder adjustment interface from the Massage Status display.



2.4 Pause button


When the massage is in progress, you can pause it instantly by pressing the "Pause" button. Press it again to restart to the massage function you were using. If you leave the massage paused for more than 20 minutes, all massage functions will automatically switch off.



2.5 Menu button

Use the "Menu" button to select the main massage function menu. The selection includes Auto function, Manual mode, Adjustment, Customise, Setting, and Device information options.


Press the "up" or "down" buttons to select menu items. Press the "OK" button to make your selection. Press the "Back" button to return to the function selection information interface.



2.6 Auto Function Interface (Auto button is also a shortcut to the Auto Function interface)

This will give you a choice of automatic modes including Fast, Comfortable, Relax, Stretch, Full body, Shoulder and neck, Back and waist and Full pressure.

Press the "up" or "down" button to select a massage function, and then press the "OK" button to select your choice of function. Press the "Back" button to return to the function selection information interface.






Note: the automatic function you have chosen will display in the massage function status bar. Press the "Back" button to check the operation.



2.7 Manual mode (use Manual button to enter the manual mode interface)

Press "menu" button to enter the main menu interface. Choose manual mode icon: includes Massage mode, Massage position, Air pressure and other massage functions.

Press "left" or "right" button to change submenu, then press "up" or "down" button to choose massage function. Press "Back" button to return to operating information interface.






3. Manual mode

3.1 Manual Massage modes

Manual Mode: includes six massage modes including kneading, tapping, kneading and tapping, shiatsu, 3D and shoulder lifting. In Tapping and Shiatsu modes, the width and speed can be adjusted. Other massage modes can adjust the speed but not stop the massage.

Press "up" or "down" button to choose massage mode icon, and then press "OK" button to confirm the massage mode is starting.




Note: Press Stop icon and all massage functions will stop. Selecting one massage mode icon and pressing Okay will start that massage mode.

3.2 Massage Area

Manual Massage Area Mode: massage spot, partial, full back, upper back and lower back.

Press "up" or "down" button to choose partial massage function icon, press "OK" button to confirm.



3.3 Air Pressure Massage Area

Manual mode (air pressure) includes upper body air pressure and lower body air pressure massage functions.

Press "up" or "down" buttons to choose different air pressure massage functions, and then press "OK" button to confirm your selection.





3.4 Others

"Others" includes Heating, Foot Roller, Negative oxygen ions, Bluetooth and other massage functions.


Press "up" or "down" to choose massage function, press "OK" button to switch the massage function on or off.



3.5 Back Heating

Press "OK" button to switch the heating massage function on or off. It will heat up in 3 minutes.


Press "up" or "down" buttons to choose other massage functions. Press "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.



3.6 Foot Roller

Press "OK" button to switch the foot roller massage function on or off.


Press the "up" or "down" button to choose other massage functions. Press "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.



3.7 Negative oxygen ions

Press "OK" button to switch the negative oxygen ions massage function on or off.

Press the "up" or "down" button to select other massage functions. Press "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.



3.8 Bluetooth

Press "OK" button to switch the Bluetooth function on or off.

After connecting, the Bluetooth in the massage chair will source a Bluetooth capable device to pair with for connection. The Bluetooth function of the smart device can be used to play music on a wireless connection.

Press the "up" or "down" button to select other massage functions. Press the "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.




4. Adjustment Function

4.1 Adjustment Menu

The Adjust button is also a shortcut to the Adjust Function interface

Press "left" or "right" buttons to access the submenu options. The 4 options are Massage – adjustment of Speed, Width and Intensity, Massage Area, Air Pressure Intensity and Time (Others) Choose massage function in the menu, then press "up" or "down" button to select function to adjust. Press "OK" button to adjust level then press "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.












While in the operating information interface, press "adjust" button to directly enter the adjustment interface.



4.2 Adjustment Function (Manual massage mode)

Adjustment function (Manual massage mode) allows you to adjust the speed, width, and intensity and so on.








Press the "up" or "down" buttons to select speed or width function. Press the "OK" button to adjust speed and width levels.

Note:

- · Speed: five levels for massage speed adjustment.
- Width: five levels for massage width adjustment when in tapping and shiatsu mode.

4.3 Adjustment function (Massage Area)

Adjustment function (massage area) when using fixed or partial massage area, whilst pressing the "up" button, the massage head will rise and stop when at the top of the range or you remove your finger; pressing the "down" button and the massage head will go down and stop when at the bottom or when you remove your finger.



4.4 Adjustment function (Intensity)

Adjustment function (adjust button-intensity) include upper body air pressure, lower body air pressure and foot roller. There are three levels to select from.

Press the "up" or "down" buttons to select air pressure intensity or foot roller intensity. Press "OK" button to adjust intensity.

Press "Back" to return to Operating Information screen.







4.5 Adjustment function (Other)

Adjustment of time setting function. Press "OK" button one time to add five minutes to your massage. After 40 minutes, it will return to zero.

Can also be used during massage to extend time by 5 minute increments.



5. Customize

Press "menu" button to enter Main Menu. Select "Customise" function to enter the customise function interface. This includes Save and Use functions for program memory I, program memory II, program memory III.


Press "left" or "right" button to choose Save or Use, press "OK" button to confirm.

Press "up" or "down" button to choose program memory I, program memory II, program memory III.

Save: save all current massage modes, air pressure, angle and other massage functions.

Use: retrieve previously saved settings, including air pressure, angle and other massage functions.


Press "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.



6. Setting

Press "menu" button to enter main menu interface, choose "setting" function icon, enter setting interface include language, backlight, lock screen and so on.


Press "left" or "right" button to switch to submenu. Press "up" or "down" button to select function or press "return" button return to operating information interface



6.1 Language

Setting (language): set language to Chinese or English

Press "up" or "down" button to choose one language, press "OK" button to confirm.



6.2 Lock Screen


Setting (lock screen) includes a choice of time lock, never lock and automatic lock when there has been no input for 2 seconds.

Press the "OK" button on the remote control to adjust the screen lock time. The screen lock time starts at 15 secs, then 30 secs, 1 min, 2 min, or never locked by each single press on the "OK" button.

6.3 Backlight

Setting (backlight) select from five levels for light adjustment.

Press "Back" to return to the operating information interface.






6.4 Device Information

Press "menu" button to enter main menu interface to select equipment information function and display current equipment information.

Press "up" or "down" buttons to select your choice, then press the "OK" button to confirm. Press "Back" button to return to the operating information interface.



7. Zero Gravity button

Press "zero gravity" button to adjust the zero gravity position. Choose "zero gravity I" or "zero gravity II" according to your requirements








8. Back Button



- 1. Power button: switch on or off (press for 3 seconds to Start)
- 2. 3D intensity Dial: 3D intensity adjustment.
- 3. Foot Rest Adjust button: adjust the length of the foot rest.
- 4. Negative oxygen ions button: switch negative ions on or off.
- 5. Heating button: switch heating on or off.

- 6. Automatic button: Scroll through Auto massage modes.
- 7. Link down button: adjust the angle of the recline.
- 8. Voice button: switch on voice control massage function.
- 9. Zero gravity button: adjust zero gravity angle.

10. Voice control operation

When the massage chair is on or in standby mode, say "Hi Alice" or press the voice control wake-up button on the right armrest to wake up the voice control function.

After the successful wake-up, the massage chair will reply "I am here". At this time, give the voice control instruction from the table corresponding to the function required within 6 seconds. The massage chair will confirm by voice and action the instruction. If there is no voice command made within 6 seconds, the function turns off and needs to be reawakened.

Note: When waking up the voice control function keep your speech rate moderate. Voice commands will be confirmed back by Alice.




11. Turn off power, stop massage

Pressing the power button during the massage will stop all massage functions immediately and return the back rest and footrest to the default position.

When the set massage time is up, the massage hand will return to its original position and all the massage functions will stop. The Backrest and footrest will not return to their original position, they can be returned to the Sitting position using the armrest controls.

The power switch key cuts power to the entire machine, as illustrated below (schematic diagram of power being cut to the machine).







1. Turn the Power off

2. Unplug the machine cord.


12. Bluetooth® Player Operation

- 12.1 Switch on the Bluetooth® function on your smart device and search for new Bluetooth® devices.
- 12.2 The device will locate Bluetooth® (IMCM-XXXX), select this and it will sync with the chair.
- 12.3 Turn on the Music Player in the smart device.


Installation

1. Installing the arm rest.


1.1 Locate the connector plug corresponding to the arm rest from the bottom of the frame and feed it out from the centre of the rear end of the frame.




1.2 After passing the connector plug from the middle of the rear end of the frame, locate the corresponding wiring plugs (docking according to the marks on wiring)




1.3 The connecting plug and the air pipe on the armrest are inserted into the connecting plug and the air pipe at the bottom of the base. Make sure the plug and air pipe are connected correctly




1.4 After the air pipe and plug are docked, tuck them into the bottom of the base and take care to avoid the air pipe pinching or crushing.




1.5 Hold the handrail with both hands. Hook the front end of the armrest, hang it onto the steel of clip on the frame and press down the front end of the handrail to lock in place




1.6 Then connect the lamp wire at the rear end of the armrest to the contector on the main body. Make sure the lamp wire is tuck into the main body. Then align the male & female buckles. And then clip into place.




1.7 Secure the rear end of the armrest with an M6*20 screw.




1.8 Then pull the upper arm holster and fix it with a M5*16 screw.



1.9 Align the mounting holes on the steel frame at the front end of the fixed armrest and tighten the armrests to the steel frame of the frame with two M5*16 screws.




1.10 Install the cover over rear end screw hole.




2. Leg rest installation


- 2.1 Cut the cable tie that is holding the wires onto the steel pipe (Figure 1).
- 2.2 Connect the connecting wire and the air pipe and the leg joint in the lower end of the frame. Then insert the docking cable and the air pipe from the lower end of the frame into the lower side of the frame, and pay attention to the plug. Don't let the pipe become pinched or crushed which could impede air flow (Figure 2).




- 2.3 Insert the rotating inner sleeve and the rotating outer sleeve into the left side of the leg rest and the right side of the lower leg (Figure 3).
- 2.4 Open the leg rest support hinge cover on the left and right mounts of the massage chair (Figure 4).



- 2.5 Then clip the lower leg (left and right shaft) into the frame support hinge plate at the same time(figure 5).
- 2.6 Cover the rotating shaft cover, press leg rest rotating cover, and then tighten leg rest rotating cover board with two M5×14-12.9 screws and a 6×12×1.5 flat pad by supplied 4# hex wrench. (Fig. 6)




2.7 After the screw is locked, insert the rear slot of the leg rest cover into the pin, and then press the front end of the leg rest cover down and the rotating shaft.
Make sure the cover is completely parallel and the leg rest is installed (Figure 7)




3. Head cushion and back rest's pad

Using head cushions can reduce the kneading massage intensity on the neck and shoulder. You can choose to use the head or neck cushions according to your needs, but they are recommended for an optimal user experience. Back rest cushions and back rest are connected by a zipper (1) head cushions and back rest are connected by thread gluing (2).




4. Floor Protection

Placing the heavy massage chair on wood may damage the floor, so please place a carpet or other barrier to avoid this type of damage.



5. Moving the chair

Make sure that all wires are well above the ground. Tilt the back rest backwards until the weight of the chair is resting on the wheels. Push the chair forwards or backwards with your hands, before returning the chair to the normal position in a slow, deliberate manner.



Note: Always turn the power off and disconnect the power cord and controller cord before moving the chair.



DO NOT pull the chair with its wheels on wooden floors, rough ground or in a narrow space. MOVING: Two or more people are required to lift the chair. Lift from the calf rest end plate (1) and back rest cover grooves (2). Do not lift arm rest directly. DO NOT lift from the leg rest/calf rest.

6. Fuse Replacement

Undo two screws to remove the top cover. Then four screws to open the power box. The fuse holder is in a protective casing inside the power box.
