We will also have booths and a presence at the NTA Western National Convention, Idaho Fur sale (promoting the NTA Convention in Sioux Falls), NTA Leadership Summit and the Wounded Warrior In Action Guide School. And let's not forget all the GFP Outdoor Campus classes, seminars and 4H mentoring sessions we attend almost every month around the state. 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

Greetings,

We are currently working on getting names for each committee for the upcoming NTA Convention.

We are in need of a committee leader for the **Camping Gate**.

This position requires 3 people to be on site 8am-9pm Monday July 22nd-Saturday July 27th. The 3 people will be stationed at the Camping Gate booth, which is air conditioned. As the campers come in, you will collect the camping fee for their entire stay, give them a receipt, hand them a camping tag to display in their vehicle and escort them to a camping site. We will have golf carts available for the volunteers to escort to the camping sites. We will not be manning the gate 24 hours a day. There will be notification of this on social media and in the American Trapper magazine. Campers will need to plan their arrival accordingly. There may be campers that do show up before Monday July 22nd. The committee leader will need to drive around the campground area to make sure every camper/vehicle has a camping tag clearly displayed and if not, will need to collect the camping fee from them. Each day the committee leader will take the camping receipts and money to a designated person from the NTA.

This position requires a lot of time! We do not have a problem if you would like to split this with a Co-Committee leader. For instance, one committee leader will be responsible Monday-Wednesday and the co-committee leader, Thursday-Saturday.

Also, because we want everyone to be able to enjoy the convention, we are not expecting anyone to be "chained" to this camping booth. The committee leaders are encouraged to find enough volunteers to fill the hours needed. 2-3 shifts per day would make it easier for all involved to be able to enjoy their time at the convention.

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The committee leaders are encouraged to find the volunteers to staff the shifts needed, but we can also go to the SDTA volunteer list and find people from that.

The **Admissions Gate** is another area that needs a Committee Leader. This position requires 3 people at the booth, which is also air conditioned, Wednesday 24th-Saturday 27th, 8am-5pm. The admissions gate is a walk-in gate only. You will collect the admission fee, give them an admissions wristband and a NTA program.

Again, we want everyone to enjoy the convention, so it's best if you can find enough volunteers to split up the shifts accordingly. We will have 10-15 people from Experience Sioux Falls that have offered to help with the admissions gate.

Ice Delivery: We will have an ice truck on site, but will need people to drive around to camping and tailgating sites and sell ice. There will be a golf cart and a cooler on site for this purpose.

Clean-Up is something most people don't like to do and frequently gets overlooked; however, it is equally as important as the Admissions gate! The Sioux Empire fair will start setting up Monday, so it is vital we have enough people helping Sunday to make sure we leave the fairgrounds clean and ready for the fair! Many hands make less work and get the work done quickly!

Please feel free to contact myself or any other SDTA director if you would like to coordinate any of these roles. I can't stress enough that you will not be doing this alone!!
