## **Greetings Trappers**,

On Saturday October 7th, Brian and Jake Hanson, myself and Nancy taught a Beginner's Trapping Education class at the Brookings County Outdoor Adventure Center. The class consisted of 14 people, ages 10- adult.

The class covered:

- 1. Trap and snare identification and function, with hands on setting opportunities
- 2. Trap and snare preparation and modifications.
- 3. Landowner permission, location scouting and actual trap and snare setting.
- 4. Fur handling, skinning, fleshing and boarding.

Brian Hanson demonstrated a dirt hole set for coyotes. Snare location and setting was done by Jake and I. The outing continued on with Brian and his grandson Kamden demonstrating proper placement of Dog Proof traps.

I demonstrated 220 trail sets with H stands.

We continued on to water sets. The students were asked where a good set location would be and several of the kids pointed out a perfect location! Jake added to the discussion about reading the area and setting the area up for the correct species.

The last segment of the day was fur handling. I demonstrated skinning a raccoon and then on to the fleshing beam. Next was boarding the coon, going into detail of what the fur buyers will be looking for.

Thank you to our fellow director Seth Shriver, for allowing us to use his portable fleshing beam!

This class was a great outreach to connect with trappers, beginners and seasoned! It doesn't matter how long you've been trapping, there is always something new to learn!


