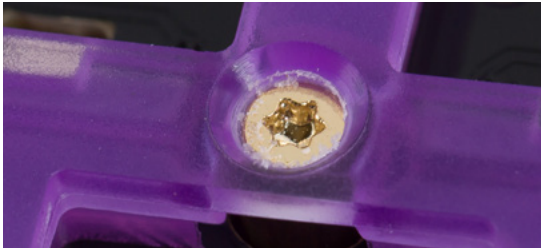

Manufacturing Standards

The following are items that fall within our normal manufacturing standards, and are to be expected with the purchase of this product.



Delicate Screws

Each screw point combines plastic and metal elements for support. Be careful when assembling, and do not overtighten, tweak, or force crossthreading



Creaking

Due to the nature of injection molded plastic, applying pressure to these keyboards will cause creaking sounds from the material flexing slightly.



Rough Edges

The process of injection molding will leave some rough parts on certain edges. None of these will be visible when the keyboard is fully assembled.



Pressure Marks

Some areas where fitting is tight, especially near stabilizers, will exhibit slight discoloration to due pressure. This is natural with the polycarbonate material used in these keyboards.



Scuffs and Cracks

Polycarbonate is prone to scuffing, and there may be some minor examples on the larger surfaces. Some cracks may be aparent, especially around screw points, but these should be superficial and not penetrate the full thickness of the plate.
