

Sowing a great lawn

Preparing a new lawn area

- Clear the area back to the soil or spray off the existing grass or weeds.

This is important because if left in place, weeds compete with newly germinated grass.

- Add a layer of Ultra-Lawn Mix across the prepared area – we recommend 20-50mm.

Ultra-Lawn Mix is

- 100% weed-free
- Contains fertiliser to nourish new grass once germination has occurred
- Is a specific blend containing sand, that allows good development.

Choosing from our Pro-Lawn Lawn Seed Blends

- Decide what you want your lawn to be fit for – play area, pets on it or fine show lawn
- Assess whether the area is sunny, shady, wet at times or very dry. Is it on clay or sand, or volcanic soil?
- Once you've answered these questions our friendly staff will recommend the right lawn seed for you – see our website for different blends

Sowing your lawn

- Use a lawn spreader to get an even distribution
- At sowing, spread Turfmaster Starter fertiliser to continuously feed for the first few months and promote good root development
- Water lightly but evenly each day following sowing, continuing for the first few weeks after germination

Tip

Use our Turfmaster Gold, an excellent slow release fertiliser, every 6 months to feed the lawn, applying every spring and autumn
